The Government of Nepal, NGO/INGo, woman group, church and



business group are trying their best to provide food who are need but it is not enough. Because of lock down, domestic violence, rape case, suicide, different kinds of crime are growing. Even in quarantine gang rape happens it is very sad news. Mental Health problems are growing. NMBS/YWCA Nepal trying our best to be with who are in need continue counseling through phone calls and messenger. Zoom virtual meetings are doing nationally and internationally.



The number of confirmed COVID-19 cases has more than double in past week and now total 6211 infected. NMBS members and staff are helping with food and other vital supplies in small way. We were able to support 18 college students and 20 families who were in need for food women living in slum area.
